Size of Local Currency Bond Market in % of GDP Source: asianbondsonline	This indicator shows the size of local currency (LCY) bond obligations as a percentage of nominal GDP. Data will be updated on an annual basis.
Size of Local Currency Bond Market Source: asianbondsonline	This indicator shows the absolute amount of local currency (LCY) bonds outstanding, categorized as government and corporates. Data will be updated on an annual basis.
Market capitalization of listed domestic companies (current US\$) Source: World Federation of Exchanges database	Market capitalization (also known as market value) is the share price times the number of shares outstanding (including their several classes) for listed domestic companies. Investment funds, unit trusts, and companies whose only business goal is to hold shares of other listed companies are excluded. Data are end of year values converted to U.S. dollars using corresponding year-end foreign exchange rates. Data will be updated on an annual basis.

ASEAN-5 Equity Index Source: Bloomberg	The equity indices are represented by the benchmark equity index for the respective countries. The ASEAN-5 comprise of Malaysia, Singapore, Indonesia, Thailand, and Philippines. The Year-to-Date (YTD) index performance charts will be updated on monthly basis.
Regional Equity Index Source: Bloomberg, MSCI	<p>The MSCI ACWI is global equity index consisting of developed and emerging market countries.</p> <p>The MSCI World Index offers a broad global equity benchmark without emerging markets exposure. It represents large and mid-cap equity performance across 23 developed markets countries.</p> <p>The MSCI Emerging Markets Index was launched over 25 years ago and is designed to measure the equity market performance of the emerging markets.</p> <p>The MSCI ACAsia ex Japan Index captures large and mid-cap representation across 2 of 3 Developed Markets (DM) countries (excluding Japan) and 9 Emerging Markets (EM) countries in Asia.</p> <p>The MSCI ACASEAN Index captures large and mid-cap representation across 4 Emerging Markets countries and 1 Developed Market country.</p> <p>The MSCI Europe Index represents the performance of large and mid-cap equities across 15 developed countries in Europe.</p> <p>The YTD index performance chart will be updated on monthly basis.</p>
Bond Index Source: Bloomberg, Investopedia	Bond Index are represented by the Bloomberg Barclays global family of indices . The Bloomberg Barclays Aggregate Bond Index is a broad-based fixed-income index used by bond traders, mutual funds, and ETFs as a benchmark to measure their relative performance. The index includes government Treasury securities, corporate bonds, mortgage-backed securities (MBS), asset-backed securities (ABS), and munis to simulate the universe of bonds in the market. The YTD index performance charts will be updated on monthly basis.

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Commodity Index Source: Bloomberg	The commodity prices are represented by the respective commodities futures contract prices.
Currency Source: Bloomberg	The US Dollar Index is represented by the DXY Index, which indicates the general international value of the USD. The US Dollar Index does this by averaging the exchange rates between the USD and the major world currencies. Other currencies are represented by the spot exchange rate against USD, respectively.
Net Flow of Foreign Funds Source: Bloomberg	The net flow of foreign funds is represented by the 4 south-east Asia emerging markets namely, Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand, and Philippines, for which fund flow data is made available by the respective exchange statistics, as reported on Bloomberg.

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
